Scoring for European-Cup Inline and Swiss Championship Track

All races are on the 200m track in the **arena geisingen**. The modern shape of the track together with the VESMACO coating will make this a high-class race.

All-over scoring

Order on the finish equals points. In case of parity after the last race, the placement will be made by the result of the longest race. If a skater does not compete in one race, the athlete gets the points of the last place plus one penalty point. Winners will be determined for each category.

Individual Competition Cadets, Youth, Junior & Senior

500m Sprint: The qualifications, semi-finals, quarterfinals and finals, all races in groups of up to 6 skaters (Rulebook of FIRS)

Points Race: According to official CEC regulations

Elimination Race: According to official CEC regulations

Dobbin Sprint: The Dobbin Sprint is a race developed by the professional skater Kalon Dobbin from New Zealand. The Dobbin sprint is a 200m (one lap) race and begins with a flying start. After the qualification, the racers with the 5 best times (best 10 for senior men and women) qualify for the final.

Please note: According to the number of participants the distances of the long race competitions could be modified.

Rules

The event is performed according to the international rules of the CEC organisation.

Time system

Times are taken by an active transponder (mylaps.com). **Please note:** Other transponders are not compatible with our system and cannot be used.

Registration

Registration for **arena geisingen international, European-Cup Inline** and **“Schweizermeisterschaften Bahn”** has to be made only via the website for the European Cup <https://europeancupinline.eu/>

Please note: Everybody, who is registered, is automatically registered for the arena geisingen international and the European-Cup Inline. The registration fee is valid only when the registration fee is fully paid.

Registration Fees

The payment of the fee has to be done via bank transfer to the bank account of arena geisingen GmbH, together with the registration. The registration only is valid after the complete receipt of the registration fee payment. The participant list will be published in regular intervals with those, who paid the full registration fee. Only the skaters, who are on the list do have the right to start. Registration fees will not be refunded.

Closing for registration

For each category we have limited places. As soon as the maximum participant number of each category is reached, the registration will be closed for this category. We recommend an early registration. The general registration deadline is the 08th of April 2022 or if one of the categories has reached the full number of participants.

Protest Fee

The protest fee is 65€. In the event of rejection, the organizer receives the fee. Protests have to be submitted not later than 15 minutes after the announcement of the official result.

Chip-Deposit

When you pick up the start numbers, **every team/club has to give an ID card or the chip value (50 € per chip in cash) as deposit.** If you bring all the chips back, you will get the deposit back! In case of not giving back transponders until Sunday evening 8pm a penalty of € 100 per missing transponder has to be paid.

Training Times

The athletes may train on the track Wednesday and Thursday afternoon, April 27th and April 28th, 2022, from 3 – 9:30 pm for free. On the competition days the arena is open for warm-up training one hour before the races start. The times for warm-up is divided up by categories.

Warm-up

When the weather is good, there is also the opportunity to warm up on the road course. Please take notice of the announcements during the competition.

Timetable/schedule

The qualification races for the Dobbin Sprint and the 500m races start on **Friday, April 29th, 2022 at 10 am!**

The arena geisingen and/or the jury reserve the right to modify the timetable/schedule at any time. Modifications will be announced and/or published.

For the Cadet category the maximum wheel size is 100mm.

For the categories Juniors, Youth and Seniors the maximum wheel size is 110mm. Size 125mm are forbidden!

Starting in a higher category

Athletes of the category Cadets, Juniors and Youth are allowed to start in the next higher category. **Please mark the start in the higher category during the registration process.** You have to pay the starting fee of the next higher category! The new category applies for the whole agi competition and also all other competitions of the European Cup and can't be changed!

Excluded from this disclaimer is the liability for gross negligence and wilful misconduct and for personal injury (damage to life, limb or health of a person). The above limitations and revisions also extend to the personal liability of employees, representatives, agents and third parties which are related to organising the event.

Health Insurance

Each participant needs to have a sufficient health insurance that is also valid abroad.

Data Protection

Due to the applicable data protection regulation, we would like to point out that images and film recordings will be made throughout the event, which may be published during and after the competition in print media, advertising media, on the Internet, the homepage, Facebook and Instagram page of the arena geisingen GmbH. All personal data of the athletes collected when registering for the competition (such as surnames, first names, dates of birth, gender, nationality and club membership) can be found before, during and after the competition on the internet, on the arena's homepage and Facebook page, in print media and film recordings are published.

Cancellation of the event/additional costs

The organizer reserves the right to cancel the event due to the pandemic situation. Reasons for this can be

- Change in the Corona Ordinance, which does not allow an event in the planned framework.
- Regulations that do not allow participants to travel from certain countries
- Increased financial effort to hold the event (e.g. increased hygiene measures)

The entry fee paid in advance will be refunded if the event is cancelled. The processing fee of €10 is non-refundable. The processing fee will also be charged by the organiser if the event is cancelled.

The refund will be made the same way as the payment was made and may take some time. Any occurring transfer fees have to be paid by the participant.

A refund in the event of a premature termination of the event is excluded hereby.

Covid-19

With the registration, each participant agrees to observe and follow the Corona regulations of the state of Baden-Württemberg that are valid at the time of the competition. In addition, by registering for the competition, each participant accepts the regulations set out by the organizer and the hygiene concept applicable to the event.

The instructions of the organizer and the staff must be followed. Failure to comply with the regulations can lead to immediate exclusion from the competition and a ban on entering the competition site.

With the registration, each participant acknowledges that due to the development of the pandemic situation, additional costs may arise for the participant, e.g. in the form of quick tests to be carried out on site. Any occurring fees within this context have to be paid by the participant.

All participants make the commitment no to enter the event site and not to contact other participants if they are knowingly infected with Corona or have symptoms that indicate a possible infection with Corona.

Quarantine

By registering for the competition, the participant agrees to follow the officially prescribed quarantine regulations in the event of a possible infection with Covid 19 and, if necessary, to go into quarantine. Additional costs for a possible quarantine in a separate accommodation are to be paid by the participant himself.
